3. Trade Promotional Activities organized in the month of December 2022

a. Mr. B.S. Mubarak, Ambassador along with Dr. Gamal A. Abdelaal Khugali, Chairman, Admin. Council, Ministry of Higher Education & Scientific Research of Sudan and other dignitaries participated at the launching of the solar system at the Gezira College of Technology on 1 December 2022. With the launching of this solar system, Gezira College of Technology will use 100% renewable energy.

As part of the outreach activities, the Ambassador of India Mr. B.S. Mubarak led a delegation visit to Nyala City, the Capital of South Darfur on 11th and 12th December 2022. The Governor of South Darfur, H.E Hamed Hanoun, convened a meeting of all Ministries and discussed important areas of collaboration between India in South Darfur, especially in the areas of agriculture and health. A series of meetings also took place with the State Ministries of Agriculture, Investment, and Finance. A special session on exploring the business partnership between India and South Darfur was organized with the Nyala Business Community.

4. (i) Trade and Commercial Delegation from India to Sudan:

 Ambassador met Mr. Sanjeev Sharma, Chief Operating Officer Tridel Technologies India on 13 Dec 22. Tridel Technologies is a multinational organization in Environmental Industry, specialized in developing end-to-end solutions for Surveying, Marine Infrastructure, Monitoring and Mapping through environmental data collection, data management and data analytics. On 10 Dec 2022, the company signed a contract for development of Damma Damma Oil Terminal Project (Phase II), with Sea Ports Corporation (SPC), Sudan. The project will lead to the construction of an oil berth and two tug berths. In past, Tridel had undertaken weather observations and hydrographic survey projects in the river Nile.

• Ambassador received a six-member delegation from Gleneagles Global Health City, Chennai (India). The hospital team visited Khartoum from 10-13 December 2022 with their key specialists from Cardiac Science, Liver Transplant & HPB, Oncology, and Plastic & Reconstruction Surgery departments. The delegation briefed the Ambassador on the hospital's collaboration with Sudan. Several areas of medical cooperation with Sudan including the exchange of visits between Doctors and capacity building were discussed. The delegation apprised that to facilitate Sudanese patients willing to go to India for treatment, Gleneagles Global Hospital opened its office in Khartoum in association with Cardman company Sudan.

Total Indian investments in Sudan up to December 2020 amounted to more than US\$ 471.5 million with 86 investment projects including 53 industrial projects, 21 service projects as well as 12 agricultural projects. (As per the National Investment Authority of Sudan)

11. Status of ongoing major investments by Indian PSUs/Pvt. Sector in Sudan, and proposed Indian Investments in Sudan:

ONGC Videsh Ltd (OVL) invested over US\$ 2.3 billion in undivided Sudan. Currently there is an arbitration going on due to default in payment by the Sudanese side.

12. Analysis of Investment opportunities in Sudan:

Despite the challenges that Sudan is experiencing in the National economic, investors from Gulf, Turkey, China, and India have already entered Sudan. Chambers and Partners have identified the following investment opportunities in Sudan:

- Natural resources/mining: especially gold.
- Agriculture: With the Nile River running through it, Sudan has more than 150 million hectares of arable land.
- Livestock: Sudan has national animal resources, which include cattle, camels, sheep, goats, poultry, horses, and an annual stock of more than 110,000 tonnes of fish. The most important animal products in Sudan are milk, meat, poultry, skins, fur and wool.
- Transport: As Africa's third-largest country and bordering seven countries, Sudan offers great opportunities for investment in the transport sector.
- Industry: Investment opportunities in industry in Sudan include following sub-sectors: agri-processing, food, spinning and textiles, leather, chemicals, pharmaceuticals, oil and soap, engineering, building materials and refractories, and printing and packaging.

- Ambassador Mr. B.S Mubarak called on H.E. Dr. Gibril Ibrahim Mohamed, Hon'ble Minister of Finance and Economic Planning of Sudan on 26 December 2022. Several areas of cooperation between India and Sudan including investments from India were discussed during the meeting.
- Ambassador received a delegation headed by the Governor of South Kordofan State of Sudan, H.E. Mr. Musa Jabr Mahmmoud on 26 December 2022 at the Indian Embassy and discussed important areas of collaboration between India and South Kordofan, especially in the areas of agriculture, health, and skill development.
- The Ambassador received Mr. Osama and Mr. Nageep from Expert Integrated Solution Co Ltd, a leading Sudanese company in Water Proofing Engineering and Exhibitions Planning and Management. It recently organized the 8th session of the Sudan Construct Show "An International Exhibition for Infrastructure and Construction" from 24-27 November 2022 at Burri fairgrounds.
